- The Manx Folk Awards are taking place in the Douglas Youth Arts Centre in Kensington Road, Douglas. There will be stewards outside the venue to guide you in. There is plenty of room for coaches to drop off and pick up. There is also 2 hour disc parking nearby or you could park in Shoprite/Chester Street car park and walk up. There is plenty of room for instruments to be left. We will be the only ones using the building.
- Where a maximum of 4 students is permitted per competition, schools may request a qualifying competition in advance of the Manx Folk Awards. We can offer assistance in the form of an adjudicator at a date to suit. Please contact mfa@online.sch.im Except where stated, all classes can be accompanied or unaccompanied. Adults should refrain from playing the tune.
- There is not a maximum number stated for the team dances but please be aware that, in Key Stage 1 especially, it is difficult to maintain circles with large numbers. Guidance and assistance can be given. Please contact mfa@online.sch.im
- This year we have asked that in the group singing competitions children learn one song that is the same so we can all have a really good sing together after the competition! In each of the classes you can sing 2 songs so you can still choose another song that you would really like to sing. You can find the set pieces by clicking HERE. An accompanist will be available if needed.
- Due to fire regulations we have had to place a maximum number on the group classes. Where asked, please state the total number of children in that class on the entry form so we know final numbers.
